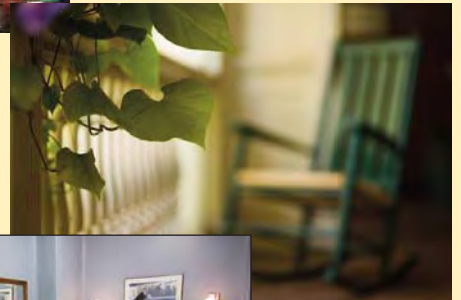


The Pavilion at McLean Hospital

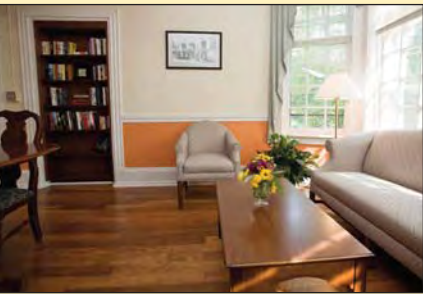
Unrivaled expertise for adults who:

Comprehensive evaluation services

Diagnostic and treatment plans take into account a patient's previous medical history and are coordinated with outpatient

providers. Special attention is paid to family issues, lifestyle changes, career challenges, stress management and other concerns. The typical length of stay is two weeks; though continued treatment is available if needed.



The Pavilion difference

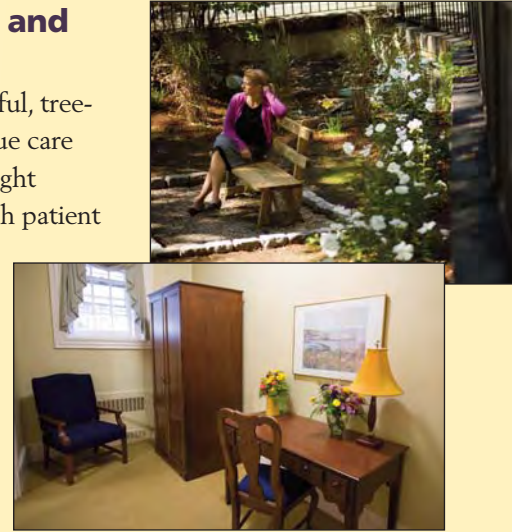
- **Privacy:** The Pavilion ensures confidentiality through its highly trained, professional and discreet staff. No third party has access to the medical records without explicit prior consent.
- **Customized care:** Treatment plans are individualized, flexible and realistically focused. Physician and patient retain total control over treatment and because The Pavilion is a self-funded program, there are no delays due to third-party precertification or restrictions on physician choice.

- **Multidisciplinary approach:** By integrating psychiatric care with a full neurologic and medical diagnostic work-up, The Pavilion can explore the biological and emotional components in the search for wellness.
- **Consistent communication:** Maintaining a dialog between staff, patients and family, as well as determining realistic treatment recommendations, result in successful transitions once a patient has returned to personal and professional life. Progress made at The Pavilion is best sustained with this supportive post-treatment approach.
